


Staff completed all the repairs and continues to improve and become more proficient in sewer and water line repairs.

BROWN ACT – SB 707

- SB 707 will substantially revise the Ralph M. Brown Act, California’s local government open meeting law. Although many portions of SB 707 take effect January 1, 2026, its most substantial revisions will take effect July 1, 2026, when new Government Code Section 54953.4 becomes effective
- Remote Meetings. Starting July 1, 2026, the public must be allowed to remotely participate in meetings of an “eligible legislative body.”
- • Remote Meeting Policy. By July 1, 2026, an “eligible legislative body” must have adopted a written policy for handling technical disruptions to the remote access.
- • Translating Agendas. Starting July 1, 2026, many “eligible legislative bodies” must translate agendas (but not agenda packets) into additional languages.

- ADA – Accommodating Disabilities of Legislative Body Members
- Executive Salaries
- Disruptive Participants
- Special Meetings
- Public Recording Rights

STREET SWEEPING - UPDATE

At the August 19th City Council Meeting, staff was directed to develop an alternate-side street sweeping program that would allow sweeping on one side of the street on one day, and the opposite side on another, thereby preserving on-street parking availability for residents.

At the December 16th Council Meeting, staff will present to the council:

- Consideration of a revised program to include alternate side street sweeping routes and restrictions
- Revised days and times for street sweeping, which would require new signage or modifications to the existing street sweeping signs
- Fiscal Impacts for increased contract costs, staffing, and equipment
- Update Chapter 22 (Traffic Regulations) of the West Covina Municipal Code to update street sweeping regulations and enforcement provisions.

EFFECTS OF A MANDATORY SPAY/NEUTER ORDINANCE

- Based on data from Los Angeles County, the City of West Covina has experienced a sustained increase in animal admissions over the past several years, particularly when compared to other cities served by the Baldwin Park Animal Care Center that have adopted mandatory spay/neuter ordinances. These rising admissions contribute to higher contract costs, driven by longer lengths of stay and a greater need for veterinary care.


